

MAY 2022 Information List

The El Camino Real District #20 AHEPA Scholarship Foundation is proud to announce a **new grant opportunity** for post graduate students. Applicant must have resided within the District 20 boundaries and currently be a member of District 20 Order of AHEPA or Daughters of Penelope; or if chosen for a grant, the El Camino Real District #20 Scholarship Foundation will pay for the applicant's one year membership in the District #20 Order of AHEPA or DAUGHTERS of PENELOPE.

An applicant may not receive an El Camino Real District #20 Scholarship Post Graduate Student Grant more than one (1) grant per year and may not receive more than two (2) grants total. Completed applications will be evaluated by an impartial panel of school administrators/college professors.

To be considered for a grant, the applicant must:

1. Be a current post graduate student enrolled in a Masters or Doctorate Program at an Education Institution in 2022.
2. Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) OF 3.4 FOR POST GRADUATE WORK.
3. Prepare a typewritten personal statement essay of 400 – 1000 words.
4. Provide two (2) letters of recommendation on official stationery.
5. Provide an official transcript of post graduate work (Masters or Doctorate)
6. Receive Order of AHEPA or DAUGHTERS of PENELOPE Chapter endorsement and verification of applicant's membership; or if the applicant is not a member of the AHEPA Family, the applicant, if chosen, will receive from the El Camino Real District #20 Scholarship Foundation, a paid membership to the District #20 Order of AHEPA or DAUGHTERS of PENELOPE. (see pg. 4 for description)
7. Signed IRS information form
8. Complete application dated/postmarked by July 29, 2022.
