#### Pete Marudas

- We have to work together as a Family in our joint efforts. In places where there are no AHEPA or DOP chapters, we have to work together to get things working.
- Working together allowed both Governors to overcome the difficulties of COVID. The two years caused District 20 to come to a near collapse. The AHEPA, during that time, went from 679 to 646 members. During this time, 12 chapters had no meeting in person or by Zoom. The District started to fall apart. In January of 2022, we removed 31 names of Brothers that have died during the COVID. This brought the AHEPA to 650 members. Through hard work we are now at 765 AHEPA members.

#### **AHEPA Housing**

Presented by Anastasios Pallas from Chapter 302, current Chapter 302 Incorporated Housing Acting President (previous President passed)

- Housing has 90 units right now.
- There are 124 on the waiting list.
  - o Changes to the waiting list occur very frequently for many reasons.
  - o If selected for a place, the candidate has to commit to move-in within 2-3 weeks.
- Last year, Income was \$800,560 from HUD, rest was from Rent.
- Expenses were \$750,000.
- o The Housing is doing well.
- Location is near Waterman Ave and Gilbert in San Bernardino, CA
- Ownership will revert in ~12 years (depending on HUD calculations)
- There are numerous offers to buy the housing, however the first choice goes to the AHEPA Management Company; During the last meeting in Mimi FL, AHEPA Management Company stated that they will give 10% above any bid.
- Chapter 302 is not getting any funds through the housing operation at this time. The Foundation gets \$8,200, which is \$90 per unit. This could go up from year to year. The foundation has to spend all for a given year.
- The AHEPA Housing has a dedicated room for Chapter 302

  - New President is Mike Orcutt
  - This chapter was down to 18 members. Now, this chapter is at 40 members and should get 5-6 more members.
- 。 302 San Bernardino
  - Great Chapter and does the job.
  - o Currently at 63 members in a very challenging area, however, keep on moving in the right direction.
- o 342 Long Beach
  - New officers elected.
  - Chapter has now 42 members with 31 on the delinquent roster
- 373 Rose Bowl
  - o Currently at 24 members and 27 on the delinquent roster
  - Need to review the delinquent roster to check who is no longer viable anymore.
- 。 411 Anaheim
  - o Currently 65 members (5 Life Members) and 29 on the delinquent roster
  - o It has got over 70 members.
- 412 San Fernando
  - 18-member chapter and 26 on the delinquent roster
  - o We need to work on this chapter.
- o 426 Redondo Beach

  - Was down to 3-member chapter for 3 years and got back to 25 members.

#### Call for nomination for the District Governor

- Floor recognizes Dean Tripodes
  - Presented qualifications and nomination of Nick Angelos for the District Governor
    - Nick Angelos is a 44-year member of AHEPA initiated September 10, 1979, in Redondo Beach, CA by past Governor Nick Wallace
    - He joined the Redondo Beach chapter in 1984 and transferred to the Ventura chapter.
    - In 1998 he served as District Warden
    - o In 1999 he was elected to District Treasurer
    - o In 2000 he continued as District Treasurer
    - o In 2001 he was elected to Lt. Governor
    - His work precluded him from taking on position of the District Governor
      - He was involved in Chapter 302 Senior Housing as a Senior Housing Committee Advisor and assisted in getting the first California District Housing.
      - He was present at the opening of the Senior Housing in 2009
      - o In 2022 he transferred to the Anaheim chapter and moved to Anaheim
      - He was part of the Church Falls in Virginia, where they laid over 600 wreaths at Arlington.
