Periclean Award

Honorable Steven G. Counelis



A parishioner of Saint John the Baptist Greek Orthodox Church in Anaheim, California, the Hon. Steven G. Counelis was invested as an Archon by His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew on October 31, 2021 and conferred with the Offikion *Nomophylax – Νομοφύλαξ* [Keeper of the Law].

Archon Hon. Counelis is Judge of the Superior Court of the State of California in the County of Riverside. He graduated Magna Cum Laude with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Government, and with his Juris Doctor degree, from the University of San Francisco. As a college student, he served at the United States Supreme Court, in the Office of the Administrative Assistant to the Chief Justice. Prior to being elected to the Superior Court in 2010, he served as a Deputy District Attorney for seventeen years.

Throughout his life, he has been active in a number of parish leadership roles. The Ascension Cathedral in Oakland, California was the parish in which he was raised and where he participated in all ministries, in particular the liturgical choir. For several years, he held each officer position on the Parish Council of Prophet Elias Greek Orthodox Church, San Bernardino, California. He currently serves as Chair of the "Prepare the Way" Strategic Planning Committee of St. John the Baptist parish, as well as the high school Sunday School instructor and a liturgical choir member.

In 2016 he was elected by the Metropolis of San Francisco Assembly to serve on the Metropolis Council, and has done so to the present. Archon Councils and his wife Stacia, with the blessing of Metropolitan Gerasimos of San Francisco, reestablished the Young Adult League (YAL) Conference Ministry of the Metropolis of San Francisco. They have served as the Conference Advisors since its renaissance in 2018, and continue to guide and mentor the Young Adult Conference Committee in the execution and planning of the annual Conference.

In September 2022, he was appointed Regional Commander of the Order of Saint Andrew for Southern California. National Commander Dr. Anthony Limberakis subsequently sent him as part of a two-Archon team to represent the Order of Saint Andrew and the Ecumenical Patriarchate at the annual meeting of the Warsaw Human Dimension Conference of the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE) in Warsaw, Poland, where they made poignant presentations promoting the religious freedom of the Holy Mother Church to the 57 member nations. The Archon team held constructive meetings with US Ambassadors and diplomatic delegations from other countries, as well as with civil society organizations dedicated to human rights and fundamental freedoms worldwide.

Our Lord has blessed the honoree with a beautiful and supportive family - wife Stacia, and teenagers Anna and Christos, and he will take every opportunity to travel together wherever and whenever possible.

AHEPA District 20 Philanthropy Award John Ohanian



John Ohanian was born in Los Angeles in 1932 and is of Armenian (on his father's side) and Irish (on his mother's side) descent. As a child, John was an excellent student and was once advanced a half grade when he returned to public school after three years at Mt. Lowe Military Academy boarding school. The boarding school's strict rules prepared John well for adulthood. John began working at 15 years of age doing basic chores at a local market. It wasn't long before John had saved enough money to buy his first car, a 1942 Chevrolet coupe, shortly after turning 16.

Starting from humble beginnings not long after graduating from high school, John became a highly successful business entrepreneur in a variety of industries. John begin his career owned and operated several produce and other markets in Orange County: first a roadside produce stand in Norwalk, then a small market in Fullerton, and finally a much larger market in Buena Park. After selling his market, John embarked on a new career, establishing and operating 20 donut shops under well-known "Jax Donuts" brand name. John was also instrumental in helping his family build the first donut shop in Greece! Later in life, John and his lovely wife Mary veered into a completely new business venture, opening a small, but classy, ladies clothing boutique in Tustin named "La Galleria." Having the store allowed John to devote more time and effort in his volunteer activities on behalf of the community.

John was introduced to the Greek way of life and the Greek Orthodox faith via marriage. In January 1967, John became an active member of the Greek Orthodox Church of Orange County in Garden Grove (later to be renamed the St. John the Baptist Greek Orthodox Church of Orange County in Anaheim). It was there that John's deep Greek Orthodox faith was ignited, and where he learned about the "Greek Drive" (the desire to achieve what to others appeared unachievable) in his fellow parishioners. For nearly 60 years, John has been a leader and pillar of the St. John the Baptist community. Whether volunteering to serve multiple terms on the church building committee, or as Greek Festival or Orange Street Fair chairman, or as a member and President of the Parish Council, or performing any number of other countless tasks for the betterment of the St. John the Baptist community,

John's boundless energy and joyful enthusiasm are an inspiration to all of us. John continues to defy Father Time with his tireless efforts on behalf of the community, and looks forward to the new challenges to come.

She progressed to District Lodge activities and was elected District Governor and District Penelope of the Year. Attendance at both District and National conventions as a delegate has been an annual adventure for many years enjoyed by Georgia and her husband Peter (Peter was presented with the AHEPA Lifetime Achievement Award earlier this year.) 


