District 20 Scholarship Foundation Announces \$63,000 in Graduate Awards

The El Camino Real District 20 AHEPA Scholarship Foundation announced nine recipients of the foundation's 2022 Graduate Grant awards. Each grantee received a \$7,000 award, which are part of the new Partner Grant Awards for Graduate Students initiated by the foundation this year.

This year's Partner Graduate Grants join the undergraduate

scholarships awarded earlier this year to 13 students at \$4,000 per student. In sum, the foundation awarded \$115,000 this year, representing the largest amount distributed in a single year in its history.

HEPA's Centennial Celebrations did not end with the conclusion of the historic Centennial Supreme Convention in July. In fact, celebrations continued in earnest over the fall. They spanned from sea to shining sea and across the Atlantic to Athens.

AHEPA's Western Region hosted a Centennial Celebration where the Order honored California Lt. Governor Eleni Kounalakis with the AHEPA Socrates Award, and the Very Reverend John S. Bakas, dean of St. Sophia Greek Orthodox Cathedral, with the AHEPA Archbishop Iakovos Humanitarian Award. Approximately 200 people attended the event, which was held at the Cathedral in Los Angeles, September 17, 2022.

Event sponsor and Ahepan George Marcus introduced Lt. Governor Kounalakis, who is the first woman elected Lt. Governor of California and the first Greek American woman to serve as U.S. Ambassador.

In acceptance of AHEPA's highest honor, Kounalakis spoke about the impact of the AHEPA family on society, and her father, Angelo Tsakopoulos' lifelong participation in AHEPA. She also spoke with pride about her Daughters of Penelope membership and her public service as California's lieutenant governor and as a former American ambassador to Hungary.

Supreme President Jimmy Kokotas introduced Very Rev. Bakas, who is retiring.

In acceptance remarks, Father Bakas recalled the contributions of Ahepans to Hellenic causes who worshiped at the Cathedral, including the late Spyros Skouras, who contributed greatly during the Greek War Relief effort.


