PRESERVING OUR HELLENIC HERITAGE

In 2004, the **Gust P. Rakus Hellenic Studies Collection** was established at the University of Washington, as part of the University of Washington Libraries and the UW Special Collections Division. Old photos, memorabilia, more than 50 years of the *Ahepa Mentor*, and an assortment of Greek American papers and publications spanning the years of 1935-2003, were donated.

The collection was fully reviewed and rehoused in 2008. It has been described as “a wonderful collection of AHEPA materials at the national and local level...and provides significant insight into the heart of the Greek American Community in the Pacific Northwest...” Nicole Bouche, former UW Libraries Pacific Northwest Curator. These materials serve as an important resource for the students and faculty of the Hellenic Studies Program, and enrich the research of local and international scholars.

The Rakus Family also has provided ongoing financial support for the acquisition of research materials, in all formats, which further the educational goals of the Hellenic Studies program and studies related to Modern Greece and Greek Americans. To date, over 300 books, exhibits, portfolios, videos and serials have been purchased, including:
