Jim was born on February 25, 1942, in Chicago, Illinois. He attended a local northside grade school until fifth grade, after which his parents scraped together their limited income to send Jim and his two brothers to a new Greek American grade school on the other side of the city. Getting there was quite a journey—they had to take two buses, and the trip took 45 minutes. The school, named Plato, was attached to The Greek Orthodox Church of the Assumption and had about 300 students. Greek American teachers taught English, while Greek teachers handled Greek language classes; as Jim recalled, the Greek teachers were famously strict. After graduating from Plato grade school, Jim went on to Lane Technical High School. Like all his siblings, Jim grew up working in the family restaurant. After he graduated from high school, his parents sold the restaurant and moved to Arizona for his father's health.



Jim started working at Motorola's military plant in Phoenix, where they were building the Gemini spaceship to compete with the Russian Sputnik. Although the projects fascinated him, Jim found that factory work wasn't his calling. During this time, he received a draft notice in 1964 from the Selective Service, asking him to report for two years of active duty in the Army. Instead, Jim joined the Marine Corps Reserves and endured a challenging boot camp. The experience gave him a tremendous boost in self-confidence. After his discharge, Jim moved to Tucson to work and attend college. He earned a degree in finance and began his dream career as a financial adviser for Paine Weber Investment Company. Jim managed clients' portfolios for over fifty years.

During his final week in college, Jim met Beth, a nursing student who was also graduating. Their first date was at a bar, enjoying beer and beer nuts—a simple start to a lasting relationship. Jim and Beth have been married for 52 years and are proud parents of two great sons, wonderful daughters-in-law, and five terrific grandchildren.

Jim's involvement in the AHEPA has been extensive. He has served as Chapter President of Tucson Chapter #275 multiple time, served as advisor for many years of the local Son's of Pericles and has also served as the District Athletic Director.

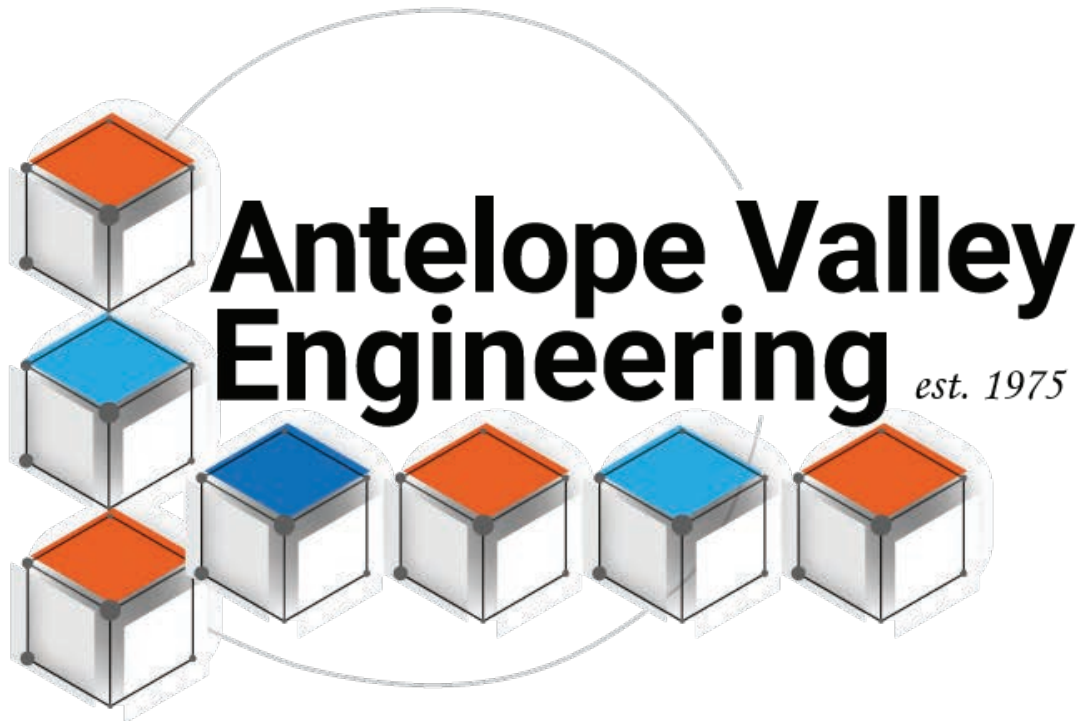

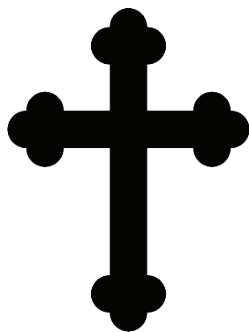
