Information List

The El Camino Real District #20 AHEPA Scholarship Foundation is proud to announce a <u>new grant</u> <u>opportunity</u> for post graduate students. Applicant must have resided within the District 20 boundaries and currently be a member of District 20 Order of AHEPA or Daughters of Penelope; or if chosen for a grant, the El Camino Real District #20 Scholarship Foundation will pay for the applicant's one year membership in the District #20 Order of AHEPA or DAUGHTERS of PENELOPE.

An applicant may not receive an El Camino Real District #20 Scholarship Post Graduate Student Grant more than one (1) grant per year and may not receive more than two (2) grants total. Completed applications will be evaluated by an impartial panel of school administrators/college professors.

To be considered for a grant, the applicant must:

- 1. Be a current post graduate student enrolled in a Masters or Doctorate Program at an education institution in 2023.
- 2. Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) OF 3.4 FOR POST GRADUATE WORK.
- 3. Prepare a typewritten personal statement essay of 400 1000 words.
- 4. Provide two (2) letters of recommendation on official stationery.
- 5. Provide an official transcript of post graduate work (Masters or Doctorate)
- 6. Receive Order of AHEPA or DAUGHTERS of PENELOPE Chapter endorsement and verification of applicant's membership; or if the applicant is not a member of the AHEPA Family, the applicant, if chosen, will receive from the El Camino Real District #20 Scholarship Foundation, a paid membership to the District #20 Order of AHEPA or DAUGHTERS of PENELOPE. - 7. Signed IRS information form
- 8. Complete application dated/postmarked by APRIL 22, 2023.

In order for your application to be considered, the following must be included in your packet:

- 1. Application pages 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5
- 2. Official original transcript of post graduate work completed to date or work in progress
- 3. Personal Statement: A short essay that highlights your personal qualities in the context of school or job applications. Somewhat autobiographical, personal essays should delve into your talents, skills, passions, ambitions and accomplishments. Something to know... when applying to schools, scholarships, or companies for a job, that institution wants to know what kind of person their candidate is.

Personal statements enable the evaluation of applicants, not just of what they say about themselves, but also how they say it. (Between 400 to 1000 words, not to exceed a single page).

- 4. Two Letters of Recommendation: Letters are to be written by someone who knows you well academically. Faculty members most commonly write letters of recommendations; however, other professionals who know you well and have supervised your work in academia or research may also be appropriate choices.
- 5. Passport-size photograph
- 6. Stamped, self-addressed #10 business envelope
- 7. Place items in a manila envelope and send postmarked no later than April 22, 2023.
